Eyeglasses/Hearing aids try an OTC Fleet enema. If you are nauseated, stop and pause for an hour. You may take OTC MiraLAX one dose in a 8 oz. Maalox or Tums may help. OK to You **CANNOT** drink alcohol or drive glass of water up to 3 times per day as needed to for 12 hours after the test. continue drinking water, apple juice or maintain daily soft BMs. You may also use your white grape juice in the evening as usual laxatives as needed.
