DO YOU HAVE HIGH CHOLESTEROL?

- Are you between 40 and 85 years of age?
- Are you currently taking a medication to treat your high cholesterol?
- Do you have a history of heart disease?

If you answered yes to these questions, you might be eligible to participate in a clinical research study.

The purpose of this research study is to see if the investigational medication may impact memory and reaction time in people with high cholesterol levels.

If you participate, you will receive study related doctors visits, lab tests and study medication at no cost to you. Reimbursement will provided for travel expenses.

Study Information

Your participation in the study may last up to 99 weeks (about 2 years). There are 12 study visits. At 6 of the visits, you will be asked to complete a test that asks you to a test that asks you to answer some simple questions or perform simple tasks.

During the study, you will continue to take your regular statin medication, if you are already taking a statin. You will also receive the investigational medication which is given using a special pre-filled injection pen. You will need to inject the medication once every 2 weeks just under the skin. The study doctor or nurse will explain how to use the injection pen and help you practice injecting the study medication.
