Bring t with you to the EUS appointment.	<ul> <li>Patients with Diabetes", which also applies to patients scheduled to have lower EUS and sigmoidoscopy.</li> <li><u>4 PM</u>: Mix 1<sup>st</sup> entire 238gm (14 dose) bottle of MiraLax together with entire 32oz bottle of Gatorade. Drink one 8oz glass every 20 minutes as tolerated. Finish 4 glasses until it is gone.</li> <li><u>7 PM</u>: Take 2 Bisacodyl Laxative tablets 5mg with a large glass of water.</li> <li><u>10 PM</u>: Insert 1 Bisacodyl Suppository into your rectum. Retain as long as comfort allows, usually 10-15 minutes</li> <li>Night: Nothing to eat or drink except</li> </ul>	OK to continue clear liquid diet. FOUR HOURS PRIOR TO YOUR CHECK IN TIME ABSOLUTELY NOTHING BY MOUTH (e.g. gum, hard candy, chewing tobacco, water, etc.).
