

<u>Position:</u> Nuclear Medicine Technologist

Care Center: Cardiology

Responsibilities:

Under the direction of the Medical Director of Nuclear Medicine, the Nuclear Medicine Technologist operates nuclear medicine equipment and injects patients with radiopharmaceuticals to produce images of specific body organ systems for diagnostic purposes. The Technologist performs daily quality control procedures on all nuclear medicine equipment as required by manufacturer recommendations and NRC regulations. The Technologist maintains all records required by Washington State agencies and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). These records include but are not restricted to records of receipt, disposition, and use of radioactive materials, radioactive survey results, radioactive source inventory and quality control logs.

- Using standardized protocols, performs Nuclear Medicine diagnostic procedures.
- Explains procedure to be performed; facilitates patients' cooperation and alleviates anxiety; addresses patients' concerns.
- Obtains patient history before procedure; accurately documents all relevant information; obtains all other diagnostic information needed to enhance interpretation of the exam with assistance from nuclear treadmill technician.
- Administers intravenously, under physician direction, prepared radiopharmaceuticals to patients for diagnostic purposes.
- Completes nuclear medicine procedures to include images or test results of diagnostic quality.
- Observes patient during the exam, monitoring patients' condition and safety.
- Performs daily, weekly, monthly and annual quality control procedures on all equipment.
- Maintains all documentation to comply with Washington State nuclear licensing and the NRC.
- Performs clerical activities associated with department operation and patient care with assistance from nuclear treadmill technician.

- Current BLS certification, preferred (can help obtain upon hire)
- CMNT (NMTCB), ARRT (N) or equivalent or/ registry eligible and exam taken within one year of employment
- Certified with the State of Washington Department of Health
